Local Dollars Making a Local Impact in the Fight Against Breast Cancer

The funds raised at the Komen Greater St. Louis Race will directly impact the breast health needs of local women, men and families. Seventy-five percent of the net funds raised through the Race stays in Komen Missouri's 38-county Missouri/Illinois service area to fund lifesaving, local breast cancer screening, breast health education and patient navigation and support programs for those who may not otherwise have access. The remaining 25 percent funds cutting-edge, global breast cancer research, including research being done in St. Louis.

The Race is Komen Missouri's signature fundraising event. Since 1999, Komen Missouri has raised and invested \$40 million in the fight against breast cancer, through events such as the annual Race. Komen Missouri has awarded more than \$30 million in community grants to local organizations that deliver breast health services in the region.

More than 100 percent of the funds raised here since 1999 has remained in and returned to the St. Louis area.

Race registration fees, fundraising dollars and donations give strength to the local fight against breast cancer.

- The most common risk factors for breast cancer are being female and growing older.
- With respect to age, race, religion and socioeconomic status, breast cancer knows no boundaries.
- Breast cancer affects more than just the person diagnosed. Co-survivors (family, friends, co-workers) feel the effects too.
- There are more than 3 million breast cancer survivors in the U.S. today.


Race Day Safety

Timed Run/Walk

The Race start is staggered, allowing the Timed Runners to start the race before the Non-Timed Run/ Walk participants. Timed runners have their own, separate starting corral positioned aside from the rest of the runners and walkers.
