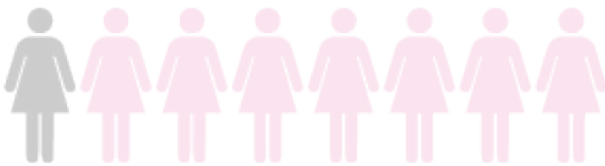


OUR PROMISE

- + 1 in 8 women in the U.S. will be diagnosed with breast cancer in her lifetime
- + Every 2 minutes, one case of breast cancer is diagnosed in a woman in the U.S.
- + Every 13 minutes, one woman in the U.S. will lose her life to breast cancer
- + There are more than 3 million breast cancer survivors in the U.S.

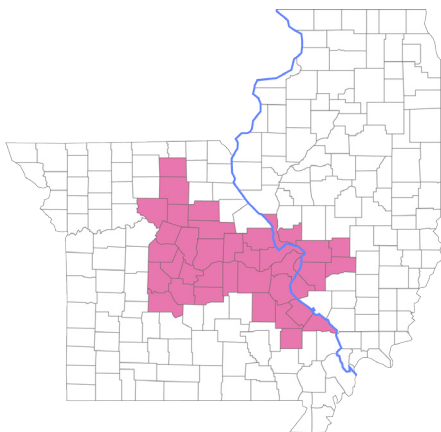
OUR INVESTMENT

25% of net funds raised supports cutting-edge, global breast cancer research.

75% of net funds raised supports local breast health programs for medically underserved women and men in our community who otherwise would not have access due to low income, lack of insurance or other barriers.

Komen Missouri has invested more than \$30 million in community breast cancer screening, breast health education, patient navigation and support programs, and more than \$9 million in breast cancer research since 1999.

At the same time, more than \$20 million raised here and nationwide has come back to Missouri research facilities.
